1. Opening of the meeting

Convener welcomed the members and opened the ISO/IEC JWG 11 meeting at 0900 on 21 March 2001. He expressed his appreciation to Italian National Committee of IEC for invitation, detailed accommodation information prepared for the meeting and the excellent facilities such as Internet connection and video projector.

2. Roll call of delegates

Secretary asked the members to introduce themselves because new members, Mr. R. Hodgkinson and Mr. J. Perry were attended the meeting. They were welcomed. Secretary also asked to signup the attendance sheet.

3. To approve Draft Agenda

Draft agenda was approved as it was.

4. To receive reports on relevant activities since the 6<sup>th</sup> (Stockholm) meeting

- 4.1 Activity in ISO/TC 145

Secretary, Dr. David Fishman, in his capacity of Secretary ISO/TC 145 made a comprehensive report covering all activities within ISO/TC 145. Relevant report to ISO/IEC JWG 11 included approval of IEC/FDIS 80416-1 and ISO/FDIS 80416-2, which would be published as ISO/IEC double-logo Standard soon taking into account comments of purely editorial nature; IEC/CD 80416-3 was also circulated and comments of ISO National Bodies were received. The report was accepted.

- 4.2 Activity in IEC/SC 3C

Convener, Prof. Hiroaki Ikeda, in his capacity of Secretary IEC/SC 3C as well, reported that IEC/FDIS 80416-1 and ISO/FDIS 80416-2 were approved also in IEC. IEC 80416-1 would be published as ISO/IEC double-logo Standard soon taking into account the comments of purely editorial nature; IEC/CD 80416-3 was circulated and received IEC National Committees' comments which were combined with ISO comments and published as JWG11 N62 with draft observation of convener. The report was accepted.

5. To discuss received comments on IEC/CD 80416-3: 'Basic principles for graphical symbols for use on equipment - part 3: Guidelines for the application of graphical symbols' N62

Based on the document N62, each comment received on 3C/606/CD and TC145 N340 was discussed and observed by the members in detail. In parallel, convener reflected the discussion and observation on-line using video projectors. All modifications and amendments were agreed to come up with a revised committee draft.

It was unanimously agreed that the draft with further clean up and necessary additions which were not able to be reflected to the draft should be sent as CDV/DIS for parallel voting by IEC/SC 3C and ISO/TC 145 to both Secretariats.

**RECOMMENDATION 1**

Revised document for the project 80416-3 should be circulated as CDV in IEC and DIS in ISO, in parallel.

6. To discuss proposed work item on ISO/IEC 80416-4: 'Basic principles for graphical symbols for use on equipment - part 4: Supplementary principles for the creation of graphical symbols for use on screens and displays (icons)' N61

Convener introduced the new input from an expert, Mr. Hodgkinson, in the field of information technology and it had been made public as JWG 11 N61 over the web-page. Convener asked Mr. Hodgkinson to outline the contribution. After the presentation, also taking into account the original proposal of German National Committee of IEC, JWG 11 discussed a technical content of the future 80416-4. A new working draft was created taking into account JWG 11 N38B, JWG 11 N61 and the discussions in the meeting. The title to reflect the technical contents was also discussed to come up with the following two recommendations.

**RECOMMENDATION 2**

The working draft should be proposed by appropriate National Body/Committee for an official NP submission.

**RECOMMENDATION 3**

The title of 80416-4 should be "Basic principles for graphical symbols for use on equipment – Part 4: Supplementary guidelines for the adaptation of graphical symbols for use on screens and displays (icons)".

7. Terminology matters

Secretary drew members' attention to ISO 17724 almost ready to be published as DIS. It is a collection of about 90 terms and definitions used within ISO/TC145. Convener noted there should be freedom to use terms with slightly different definition for the sake of a specific International Standard.

8. Any other business

No any other additional business was raised.

9. Date and place of next meeting

The next meeting of ISO/IEC JWG 11 would be held in Munich by the kind invitation of a German expert in the week of 26 November 2001.

NOTE – The actual date will be confirmed to synchronize with availability of National comments and votes.
